

LOCATIONS AND TIMES for rehearsals and shows:

All-Cast Run-Through on TUESDAY, April 18th at the 4H Center in Ridgway

- Pre-Ballet Students need-not attend.
- Aerial Silks performers do not need to attend this rehearsal.
- ALL other students MUST attend.
- Makeup is **NOT** required.
- Hair is NOT required. HOWEVER, students should follow the regular dress code for hair and uniform on this day (leotard and tights). If you don't normally wear leotards and tights to class, refer to your normal class dress code.
- **NO costumes needed** for this rehearsal -- for anyone.
- ***Miss Natasha has taken a great amount of time to show you on paper --- exactly where you student is in the show order (highlighted) and that should give you a pretty clear idea of where your student is in the show --- AND how far into the act they are time-wise. Please read it. It will be accompanying the costumes.***
 - Act 2 will run first, STARTING at 5 pm. We will not start late. We expect this will take 1.5 hours total. All students in Act 2 should expect to stay for the full hour to hour and a half (Act 2). (pickup appx 6:30)
 - We will run the final bows & finale in the middle (all students should be present for this (except pre-ballet and primary ballet). We expect this to start promptly at 6:15 and be done within 10-15 minutes.
 - Note on **Intermediate Hip-Hop**: Plan to run your part with the carriage during the finale run in the middle.
 - Act 1 will run second, All students should be there by 6:10 pm. Final Bows and Finale will be practiced with Act 2 first, then we will get into Act 1. We expect this will take 1.5 hours. All students in Act 1 should expect to stay for the full hour & a half (Act 1), until appx 7:45 pm.
 - ALL PARENTS SHOULD BE ready to pick-up students NO LATER than 8 pm.
 - Parents ARE allowed to watch this rehearsal from the back and sides. If you are there, please help by managing the behavior of your children. Set expectations such as: no rough-housing, running, etc.
 - **Side Note: we have some great sponsors in Ridgway and Ouray that you all could support during this rehearsal. Specifically: Colorado Boy.. Be sure to tell them "Thank you" and let them know you're with Weehawken!**

All-Cast DRESS AND TECH Rehearsal on THURSDAY (April 20th) at the Montrose Pavilion

- SORRY, no parents are allowed in the theater for this rehearsal *unless they have signed up for a volunteer position that is actually 'in' the theater during rehearsal.*
- You are welcome to be in the lobby or romper room area, but not "in" the theater. *Thank you.*
 - Side Note: we have some great sponsors in Montrose that you all could support during this rehearsal. Specifically: Chili's is doing a give-back event April 20-22. Be sure to mention you are with Weehawken so we can get the "give back" credit!
- INCLUDES ALL PRE-BALLET STUDENTS AND AERIAL STUDENTS.
- ALL students with costume, with makeup, and with hair done and ready for a show UPON ARRIVAL.
- ACT 1 will run first (be ready to start by 5:00 pm)
 - Call Time: Arrive by 4:30 pm - ready to go at 4:45
 - Announcements will begin at 4:45. Places at 5:00
- Final bows and finale will run in the middle (this is all-cast) at appx 6:30 pm. We expect this will be completed by 6:40 pm
 - Intermediate Hip Hop: Plan to do your part in finale at approximately 6:30 pm, hopefully done by 6:45 pm
- ACT 2 will run second (arrive by 6:20 pm)
 - Call Time: Arrive by 6:20. We expect to Start by 6:30 with bows and finale.
 - We expect that this will run for 1.5 hours.
 - We anticipate that we should be done no later than 8 pm.
 - This is a highly technical show.
 - If there is a significant problem, it might go to 8:15.
 - Plan on picking-up Act 2 at 8 (we'll cross our fingers with you).
- AFTER this rehearsal, you may OPT to leave your costume pieces either in the romper room or the dressing rooms. It's your choice. HOWEVER, you should do whatever is best for you with regard to MAKING SURE your child will arrive with everything they need (shoes, costume pieces, tights, robe, etc) for the show on Friday.
 - If they are missing a piece, the show goes on without it. We will not fix the problem.
 - It's your decision as to what you can manage best within your household.
 - Some items (accessories and props) STAY backstage.

PERFORMANCES at the Montrose Pavilion

- Come to each show with makeup and hair DONE

Show starts on Friday at 6 pm

- *POSED PHOTOS: if you wish to take a photo of your child on-stage prior to the performance and “pose” them. You may do so from 4:00-4:45 pm. NO entry permitted in the theater after 4:45 pm.*
- *Nobody is needed before 5:00 pm, unless specified by your teacher, or if a parent is volunteering for an earlier shift.*
 - *We are not providing volunteers to supervise your children until 5 pm.*
 - *All students should be accompanied by their parent or guardian up until 5 pm.*
- Act 1 must be at the theatre by or before 5:45 pm (with hair and makeup done & costume-ready).
- Act 2 must be at the theatre by or before 6:45 (with hair and makeup done & costume-ready).

Show starts on Saturday at 2 pm

POSED PHOTOS: if you wish to take a photo of your child on-stage prior to the performance and “pose” them. You may do so from 12:00-12:45 pm. NO entry permitted in the theater after 12:45 pm.

Nobody is needed before 1:00 pm, unless specified by your teacher, or if a parent is volunteering for an earlier shift.

We are not providing volunteers to supervise your children until 1 pm.

All students should be accompanied by their parent or guardian up until 1 pm.

- Act 1 must be at the theatre by or before 1:45 pm (with hair and makeup done & costume-ready).
 - Act 2 must be at the theatre by or before 2:45 pm (with hair and makeup done & costume-ready).
- **ON SATURDAY, PLEASE PLAN TO STAY AFTER THE SHOW TO HELP!**
 - We need help with striking the set, checking-in and sorting costumes, picking-up trash in the theater, carrying things to the transport trucks at the back and loading trucks. With plenty of help, this only takes an hour. *Even if you only have 30 minutes, your help would be great.*
 - **Costume Check-In** will be directly after the performance on Saturday and will also be available on Friday for Pre-ballet students after their numbers.
 - *If you are not going to be at the show Saturday you must check your costume in on Friday after the show to SARA OR LISSETTE in the Romper Room.*
 - **NEW THIS SHOW: Early costume check in will be allowed for young students, and dancers are able to bow in street clothes.** This is in an effort to alleviate the lines at check-in after the show on Saturday.
