RAMS (RIDGWAY AREA MOUNTAIN BIKE SCHOOL) / WEEHAWKEN WILD (MONTROSE ADVENTURES)

Expanding our offerings in movement arts, Weehawken's Ridgway Area Mountain Bike School (spring 2020) or Weehawken Wild program offers kids the chance to gain new skills and confidence and to learn to love the outdoors and nature, while fostering independence in them. Additionally, we can expect that this program will encourage a healthy lifestyle and increase cognitive performance, both of which could have lifelong impact. We want to build basic bike and outdoor skills including maintenance and safety in a fun environment with experienced and passionate coaches.

Underwriters are needed to help with costs of scholarships, insurance, coaches, background checks, storage and acquisition of bikes and equipment for scholarship students, snacks, and generally keeping the program affordable and accessible to all. We are open to in-kind item donations to the program if they address program needs (ex: equipment, snacks, program t-shirts, etc) Donors at \$250 and above

will get an invite to our annual Donor Appreciation Event (Fall 2020)

NEEDS-BASED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM UNDERWRITER (BENEFITS IN BLACK BOX BELOW)

Help underwrite our successful and established scholarship program, which has been in-place since 2008 to address community needs and ensure that those who wish to participate, can. This program includes a "Needs-Based" scholarship application that typically offers anywhere from a 50% scholarship to a full scholarship and a "Nominated Needs-Based" Scholarship, which allows for an any adult from outside of a family to apply for a scholarship on an interested student's behalf. Scholarships are underwritten by donors, who are mostly individuals in the communities and in some cases, scholarships are underwritten by specific grants (for example, the Ouray County Community Fund has funded scholarships in the past).

DANCE PROGRAM (BENEFITS IN BLACK BOX BELOW)

Our Dance program has a 12-year proven record of encouraging young students to develop physical fitness, appreciation of the body, concern for sound health practices, and effective stress management approaches. The program teaches the values and skills of creativity, problem solving, risk taking, making judgments in the absence of rules, and higher-order thinking skills. Further, one of our core program values is KINDNESS, where students learn to value being a good neighbors and are encouraged to see and experience the value of community. Underwriters are needed to help with costs of classrooms, scholarships, insurance, equipment, costume purchases, costume and set storage and dancewear for scholarship students, classroom security, backstage security, and generally keeping the program affordable and accessible to all.

YOUTH **THEATER** PROGRAMS (BENEFITS IN BLACK BOX BELOW)

Over the past two years, we have had three wonderful youth theater teachers move to the area. There's no way we will let these opportunities pass us by! High-quality teachers make for great programs (our dance program is a great example of this!). Numerous studies have demonstrated a correlation between drama involvement and academic achievement. In addition to having higher standardized test scores than their peers who do not experience the arts, students who participate in drama often experience improved reading comprehension, maintain better attendance records, and stay generally more engaged in school than their non-arts counterparts. Underwriters are needed to help with the costs of developing, growing and stabilizing this program. Costs include securing a teaching artist, production rights, musical direction, music rights, sets, costumes and classroom and performance space.

ACCESSIBLE YOUTH ART PROGRAMS (BENEFITS IN BLACK BOX BELOW)

The barrier to participation in our youth arts programs is often price. However, as an organization, we feel strongly that access to these programs, regardless of cost, is crucial. Participation in arts programs points to better academic outcomes -- particularly with students of low socioeconomic status. Those who have a history of in-depth arts involvement earn better grades and have higher rates of college enrollment and attainment. Further, youth who participated in extensive art experiences are more likely to show civic-minded behavior than young adults who did not, with comparatively high levels of volunteering, voting, and engagement with local or school politics. Underwriters are needed to help with costs of stabilizing after school arts programs, class-rooms, scholarships, teachers, supply storage and art supplies.
